

IRWD pioneered the use of recycled water with a system of purple pipe that spreads throughout the District. Using recycled water is important because it stretches our drinking water supply even further. **The state water use reduction mandate does not apply to the use of recycled water.**




IRWD pioneered the use of purple piping which has become the international symbol for recycled water.

Each drop of recycled water that we use to irrigate medians, agriculture, flush toilets and for cooling towers is a drop of drinking water that we save for our customers.

In the IRWD service area, recycled water is used primarily for landscape and agricultural irrigation. In fact, almost all agriculture in the IRWD service area uses recycled water. Landscape irrigation uses include parks, school grounds, golf courses, freeway landscaping and irrigation of common areas managed by many homeowner associations. In addition, it is used in industrial processes, toilet flushing in office buildings, in cooling towers and on construction sites.


