Dear Mr. Sterchi,

Enclosed please find copy of the completed Delivery Certification Form for the Water Quality Report (Consumer Confidence Report CY2014), the SWRCB-DDW initial invitation to prepare the CCR2014, and DRINC portal upload acknowledgment of 6/15/2015, (Attachment A), and a printed copy of CCR2014 (Attachment B). During two bimonthly water billing cycles of June and July 2015, we added a message to the Utility Service bill, as shown in the model water bill and 'bill stuffer' (Attachment C), to inform the City's potable water customers that the electronic version of the CCR2014 is available online via City's website from July 1, 2015. It was also uploaded to the DRINC portal on 6/15/2015. Nineteen residents who responded to the message in their water bill were sent a hard copy of the CCR2014. Currently nineteen (19) hard copies have been mailed to residents of the City of Del Mar, who requested a hard copy.



Victor,

You're correct on the Bromate foot note. I was looking at the larger NOTES line at the bottom of the page and missed the indented asterisk for the foot note under the bromate section. And I see you have the square brackets around [Chloramines as Cl2] which identifies the values as [MRDL]. I usually see the values with brackets also as [4.0] and missed them on the contaminant name. Also, for City of San Diego I see the DBPs identified with MRDL brackets and I had missed that. TTHM and HAA5 are regulated by an MCL so no brackets. I'll bring that up next year with Doug.

My apologies on the mistakes and thanks for letting me know.

A few things I noticed in the CCR:

On page 1 please replace "Department" with State Board.

Chlorine values on page 2 should have square brackets to indicate an MRDL.

Bromate has a single asterisk that corresponds to the TTHM HAA5 footnote. The bromate DLR has a double asterisk that corresponds to range footnote. This may be a typo or footnotes need revising.

All compounds with an average of ND and a range of ND – ND can be removed (CCR is for detected contaminants) but you can leave them in if you choose.





Thanks Victor. Just wondering why the 2015 Pb Cu results will be included in the CCR for the 2014 calendar year. The guidance document calls for reporting the most recent results for contaminants monitored less than once per year which would be your June 2012 Pb Cu results. These results are still valid for the 2014 monitoring year. Not sure if there is anything wrong with it but thinking that if we ran into a invalidated/replacement sample situation we could be running close to or past the July 1st due date.

I'll inquire on this tomorrow and get back to you.

Also enclosed the bill stuffer that we (i.e. CoDM – Finance Department) use to inform City of Del Mar water consumers that they can find the CCR2014 online via City's website, or by request to receive a printed hard copy of the same SWRCB-DDW approved CCR2014.

Note that currently we are in the process of our triennial Lead and Copper sampling, the results will be known around 6/18/2015, there is a placeholder in the draft CCR2014, for the 90th percentile results.

Sample bottles will be delivered to the 23 participating addresses tomorrow Thursday 6/4/2015, and collected either Friday 6/5/2015, and or Monday 6/8/2015, then delivered for analysis to Applied Industrial Microbiology Laboratories, Inc. of Vista, CA. Test results will be shared with your agency, and with OK will be inserted in the final CCR2014, ready for publishing online and in hard copy available from City's front desks, and mailed out to residents that request(ed) a hard copy of same.

This email is a reminder to inform Community Water Systems and Nontransient-Noncommunity Water Systems that the SWRCB Division of Drinking Water San Diego Office is now reviewing Draft Consumer Confidence Reports (CCR) for the 2014 operating year. A Draft submittal of your Draft CCR (or a submittal of all data and text/language to be used in the final printed version of your CCR) is required to be reviewed and approved by DDW prior to final printing, delivery to your water system customers, and final submittal to DDW. If you have already contacted DDW about your 2014 CCR please disregard this email.

Transient-noncommunity Water Systems are not required to prepare a CCR. If you are unsure of the classification of your water system please contact Alan Tell at 619-645-2573 or your DDW San Diego Office water system engineer.

The preferred method of submitting a Draft CCR to DDW is by attaching your draft report as a Word, Excel or PDF document to an e-mail and sending it to alan.tell@waterboards.ca.gov <<mailto:alan.tell@waterboards.ca.gov>>. Following a review by DDW and corrections and final editing by the water system, the CCR will be ready for printing, delivery, and final submittal. Delivery to water system customers and final submittal to DDW must be completed by July 1st, 2015.

Delivery of your 2014 CCR to water system customers must meet the "direct delivery" requirements described in the attached CCR guidance documentation. This information is also available at the SWRCB CCR website at

http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/drinking_water/certlic/drinkingwater/CCR.shtml. If you are sending your customers a postcard or billing insert notifying them of the availability of your electronic CCR, you must send in your Draft postcard/ billing insert to DDW for review along with your Draft CCR. If you have questions on direct delivery methods please contact Alan Tell at 619-645-2573 or your DDW San Diego Office water system engineer.

Delivery of you 2014 CCR to DDW must be by 1) uploading a copy to the DDW DRINC Portal and 2) mailing a copy to the DDW San Diego Office. Both of these submittal methods are needed to meet the requirement to provide a copy of the 2014 CCR to DDW. E-mailing or faxing a Final CCR will not be accepted as delivery to DDW.

Instructions on how to prepare your CCR have been made available online at the SQRCB CCR website at http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/drinking_water/certlic/drinkingwater/CCR.shtml. If at any time you have questions on preparing your CCR contact Alan Tell at 619-645-2573.

CCR Certification Form

The 2014 CCR Certification Form must be submitted in hard copy to the DDW San Diego Office. The due date for submittal of the 2014 CCR Certification Form to DDW is October 1st, 2015. The certification form can also be mailed in at the same time you deliver the CCR to your customers (preferred) or at any time prior to the due date.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCESS TO UPLOAD YOUR CCR TO THE DRINC PORTAL

DRINC Portal Registration

In order to ensure the integrity of the documents collected, DDW has an on-line registration process to ensure that only valid water system representatives access the California Drinking Water Information Clearinghouse DRINC Portal. If you will be responsible for uploading the CCR for your water system you must complete registration at the DRINC Portal. To complete registration, go to <http://drinc.ca.gov/dnn/default.aspx> and click on Electronic Annual Report System, then click on the Registration tab on the right side of the menu bar. If you are responsible for CCRs for multiple water systems you only need to register once but you will need to select the different water systems you are responsible for. Within 3 to 5 days after you have registered and DDW has reviewed your registration, you will receive an email to allow you access to upload the CCR for your public water system(s).

If you are currently registered as a user on the DRINC Portal, you do not need to register again to upload the 2014 CCR.

How to submit the CCR on the DRINC Portal

The California Drinking Water Information Clearinghouse (DRINC Portal) is located on the web at <http://drinc.ca.gov/dnn/default.aspx>. To upload your 2014 CCR, go to the MY CCR UPLOADS tab and click the link Upload new 2014 Consumer Confidence Report. You will be prompted to browse your computer to select the document and upload the CCR to the DRINC Portal.

If you need to add another water system to your registered list:

To register for a new water system you must login to the DRINC Portal using your user name (e-mail address) and password, then go to the MY PROFILE tab and add a water system from the list. Within 3 to 5 days after you have added the new water system to your list, and DDW has reviewed your registration, you will receive an email stating that you are able to upload the CCR for the newly added public water system(s).

If you forgot your password or changed email addresses:

Password: You must first login using your user name (e-mail address). When you are at the screen requiring your password, click on the link [Forgot Password?](#). A temporary password will be forwarded to your email account. You must replace the temporary password with a new password the next time you access your DRINC portal account.

Email Address: If your email address has changed, you must re-register to create a new account with the updated email address. You must also add your water system(s) to the your new account before you can submit a 2014 CCR.

Upload only a single file

The uploaded CCR may be in any file format, e.g., PDF, Word, Excel, ZIP, JPEG, or GIF, as long as it is uploaded as a single file. Your CCR must be uploaded to the DRINC Portal as a single file. Uploading more than one file will result in only the last uploaded file being submitted. For example, if you upload your water quality data table in Microsoft Excel and then upload your text and language in Microsoft Word, only the text and language Microsoft Word file will be submitted. In cases like this both documents must be combined into one file, such as scanning both files into one PDF document or an image file.

Confirmation of Receipt of the 2014 CCR to the DRINC Portal

The registered user who uploaded the 2014 CCR for your water system will receive an email notification from the DRINC Portal administrator that the upload was successful.
