Jennifer McGrath was named as the City Attorney by the Council following a search. McGrath has 15 years of experience in law, became a charter officer appointed by the Council.

McGrath, 47, served as the deputy city attorney for Huntington Beach before being elected to City Attorney for the community. She currently is in private practice.

"I'm very excited to join the team in Merced, I'm excited with the opportunities here," McGrath said. "The UC community and the High Speed Rail are significant challenges. I am looking forward to working with the new City Manager and we have the opportunity to create the future."

She has been involved with downtown issues, development of a new senior center, business improvement districts, a new city charter, employee negotiations and housing programs.

"I'm a public lawyer at heart," she said. "I'm there for the citizens and I'm there for the City."

Although she spent the last 20 years in Huntington Beach, McGrath said she is a natural fit in Northern California.

She was born in Fremont and spent her early years in the Bay Area. As a youngster, she said, "I spent most of my sum-

She received a degree in political science from UCLA and graduated from McGeorge School of Law, where she was in the top 5 percent of her class.
