To Santa Ynez Rancho Estates Residents:

We were made aware this morning of an error on the 2017 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) that was distributed to you in mid-March of 2018; on the initial report you received, Iron results were reported in parts per million (ppm). The report calls for results to be reported in parts per billion (ppb).

Iron was sampled at Santa Ynez Rancho Estates on February 7, 2017; results ranged from non-detect (ND) to 44 ppb. The average level detected was 22 ppb. As previously reported in the CCR distributed to you, these results are below the secondary Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) of 300 ppb for Iron.

The secondary MCLs were set to protect you against unpleasant aesthetic effects (e.g., color, taste, and odor) and the staining of plumbing fixtures (e.g., tubs and sinks) and clothing while washing.
