





- The Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) Surcharge for the Ventura County District will be implemented to collect \$0.0575 per 100 gallons for over 18 months. The average residential bill will increase by \$8.34. The revenue collected offsets reductions in water sales during the 2015 drought.
- Your bill will reflect an ongoing average increase of \$0.67 per month from the Interim Rate True Up effective Feb. 1, 2016 for the Consolidated Expense Balancing Account (CEBA). This change reflects an update to the Interim Rate True Up, as part of the 2013 General Rate Case (GRC) decision for the Ventura County District.
